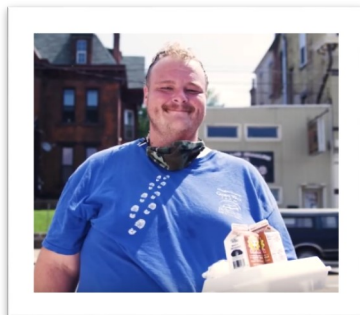

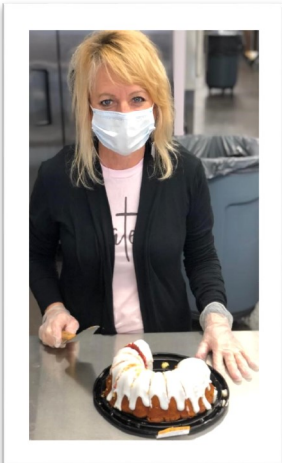

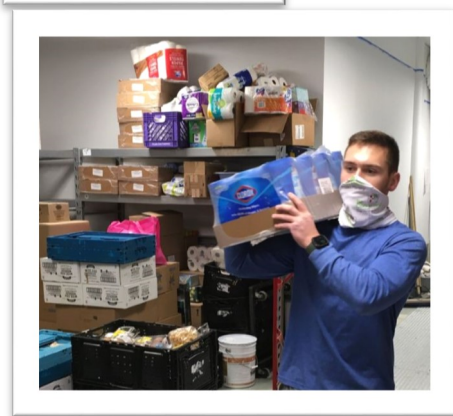

Cheeseburger Mac

(50 servings to a pan)

5 pounds lean beef

2 cups onion

1/4 cup garlic powder

1/4 cup onion powder

1 tbsp. salt and ground pepper to taste

1 1/2 pounds elbow macaroni

5 pounds reduced-fat processed cheese (Velveeta) cut into small pieces

1/4 pound of butter melted

8 cups milk

- Directions: 1. Cook and drain macaroni, add melted butter and cheese
2. Brown and drain ground meat, onion, garlic, onion powder, salt and pepper.
3. Stir macaroni cheese mix, ground meat mix and milk
4. Put into pan, cover with foil and bake at 350 until bubbling
